Sgt King was involved in a foot-pursuit of an individual he had observed being armed with a handgun. This subject had been pointed the weapon at people on West Dean Ave just prior to officer contact. Several officers, along with Sgt King, cornered the suspect behind a residence at [redacted] West Dean. The suspect was initially laying on his stomach and refused verbal commands. When the subject sat up his back was to a fence and he was seated in tall grass where officers could not see his hands. Sgt King fired his taser at the subject's midsection after he again put his hands down in the grass.

**NARRATIVE**

On 08-31-2010 at about 1924 hours I responded to the area of [REDACTED] W. Dean on the report of a male with a gun. Complainant Andy Louie was calling to report that there was a young Indian male with a white shirt and white pants pointing a gun at people at that location.

I arrived onscene and parked a block to the south. Other Officers onscene advised that the male was running w/b in the alley to the north of Dean. Officers then advised that the suspect was running s/b through yard. I went to the alley just south of Dean to cut the suspect off if he crossed Dean.

Officer in foot pursuit advised that he crossed Dean, s/b. I was in the alley and did not see the suspect come into the alley. The suspect was located by other Officers hiding on the west side of the residence at [REDACTED] W. Dean. See other Officers reports for information. The suspect was identified as 18-yr old Aaron R. Bebee ([REDACTED] 1992). Officers also located a realistic looking b.b. gun.

I responded to [REDACTED] W. Dean to check for possible victims and witnesses. There were several people standing in the area. I contacted Sherry Rainwater outside of [REDACTED] W. Dean.

The addresses of [REDACTED] W. Dean and [REDACTED] W. Dean are apartments in the same building. According to Rainwater, she lives at [REDACTED]. She told me that she knows the suspect Bebee because he has been [REDACTED] for several weeks.

Rainwater told me that she was standing on her front porch and Bebee was in front of the residence with several other people. She told me that she knew that Bebee was drunk and he usually causes problems when he is drunk. She told me that Bebee started to walk up towards her

porch. She said that she told Bebee that she did not want him on her porch because he was drunk.

Rainwater stated that Bebee was upset and pulled out a gun of his waist. She described the gun as a black semi-auto. She told me that she was pretty sure it was a b.b. gun because she heard Bebee and other people talking about the gun earlier. She told me that she told Bebee to leave and he yelled at her that he was going to get his "homies" and burn down her house and everybody in it.

Rainwater stated that one of the other males in the yard grabbed the gun away from Bebee and threw it. Bebee then went and retrieved the gun. She stated that police then arrived in the area.

I asked Rainwater if she felt Bebee would carry out the threat. She told me that she believes he would carry out the threat because he is a "Deuce 4" gang member and he knows violent gang members.

I was unable to locate any witnesses at the scene who saw the incident.

I contacted the original complainant Andy Louie. According to Louie, he is the landlord of [REDACTED]. He told me that he had driven to the location because the occupants of [REDACTED] were supposed to be moving out. He told me that when he drove up by the front of the residence he saw the suspect male at the front of the residence. He described the male as white or Native American, wearing a white shirt and white pants.

He said that he was sitting in his car and saw the male at the porch [REDACTED] yelling at Sherry Rainwater. He told me that he could hear Rainwater yelling at the male to get away from her porch. He told me that he saw that the male had a black semi-auto looking handgun in his hand. He saw the male pointing the gun at Rainwater and hear him yell "I am going to burn your house down".

He told me that a white male wearing black grabbed the gun away from the male and threw it in the street. He stated that the males started pushing each other. The suspect male then went and picked the gun back up. He said that police then arrived in the area as the male was going w/b in the alley to the north.

Based on the evidence and information available I found that there is p.c. to arrest Aaron Bebee for Felony Harassment (Threats to Kill). Bebee was arrested on that charge and an outstanding misdemeanor arrest warrant. Other Officers onscene advised there was also p.c. for M.I.P., Obstructing, and resisting.

Ofc. Wheeler transported Bebee to jail where he was booked.

On 8-31-10, I respond to a "Person with a Weapon" call at [REDACTED] W. Dean. I located the suspect, chased him on foot, and deployed my Taser on him. I also developed Probable Cause for Obstructing, Resisting Arrest, and Minor in Possession of Alcohol by Consumption. I was wearing the department authorized jumpsuit uniform and driving vehicle #221, an unmarked Police car.

On 8-31-10, at 1925, I responded to 'across the street from' [REDACTED] W. Dean on a report of an Indian Male wearing a white shirt and white pants pointing a handgun at people. Corporal Vigesaa and I arrived on scene at the same time. Corporal Vigesaa was approached by the complainant and relayed information the suspect was now in the north alley between Dean and Gardner streets, west of Nettleton.

I drove up to the alley and entered it westbound from Nettleton. I immediately saw a person matching the suspect's description walking approximately mid-block in the alley. He turned and saw me, then turned south behind a garage where I lost sight of him (later identified as [REDACTED] W. Dean). I parked my car and approached on foot, notifying Radio of this. As I peaked around the corner of the garage, I did not see anyone. I scanned the area from the corner of the building and, looking underneath some vehicle parked along the east side of the house, I could see someone standing out of my sight in front of a van that was parked there.

I moved to a position of cover behind another car. Just as I did this, I saw the male suspect, later identified as BeBee step out to the west from behind the van. BeBee was now between the van and the house. I saw BeBee was looking to the east where other officers were arriving on scene. As he turned his body, I saw that he had a handgun in his hand. BeBee then moved back behind the van. From my position of cover behind a car, I yelled at BeBee, "Police! Stop! Drop the gun!" Instead of complying with my commands, BeBee turned and ran to the southwest, quickly disappearing from my view.

I gave chase to BeBee and advised Radio. As I came out between the houses, I saw BeBee crossing Dean and running southwest. I again yelled at BeBee, "Police! Stop! You're under arrest!" It appeared to me

that as he was running, BeBee was placing something in his back waistband. BeBee turned and looked at me as he continued running, then turned and looked to the east, where other uniformed officers were approaching. BeBee then ran along the east side of [REDACTED] W. Dean and disappeared from my sight.

I saw that the officers approaching from the east were entering this same yard, so I entered the block two houses to the west of this. All officers came out into the south alley of Dean. Corporal Vigesaa had taken a perimeter location here and advised BeBee had not come out to this alley. Shortly after this, Officers Ottmar and Stone located BeBee along the west side of [REDACTED] W. Dean, in a small area approximately three feet wide between the house and a chain link fence.

Officers were at the southwest corner of the house and had already given BeBee several commands to show his hands with their guns drawn when I got to a position along side of them. I saw that there were also officers directly to the north of us, putting all of us in a crossfire situation. BeBee was now sitting on his butt facing to the east with his back up against the chain link fence. This area was heavily overgrown with bushes and weeds, partially concealing BeBee. BeBee was refusing all of the officer's commands to get his hands out and to get on his stomach. BeBee would raise his hands, and then lower them back into the bushes out of our view.

At this point, there was Probable Cause to arrest BeBee for Obstructing and Resisting Arrest. BeBee was reported to have been pointing a gun at people prior to our arrival. I had seen BeBee with the pistol in his hand. It was unknown where it was located and BeBee was now intentionally placing his hands directly out of our view, potentially to access this gun. BeBee was purposefully not following officer's direct and legal commands to place him under arrest. For these reasons, I deployed my Taser probes into BeBee to control him.

I fired my Taser and BeBee's body immediately locked up. While he was incapacitated, I continued to give BeBee orders to get on his stomach and to get his hands out. After the five second cycle, I continued to give BeBee these orders, but now that he could comply, he still refused.

I did not want to give BeBee any further opportunity to access his handgun, so I again activated my Taser. I then directed officers to take custody of BeBee while he was immobilized, which they did. I shut off the Taser once officers had direct physical control of BeBee, (see their reports).

As officers were escorting BeBee out of his place of concealment, I could smell the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on the twenty-year-old's breath. BeBee stated that the gun was a BB gun. Officers located it on the ground on the north side of Dean, a short distance away from where I had spotted him with it. It was a BB gun.

I collected the gun. Officer Stone took custody of it and the expended Taser cartridge. Corporal Vigesaa placed both of these on Property. Fire Department and AMR personnel arrived and removed the Taser probes from BeBee. He was medically cleared for Jail. Corporal Keller took photographs of BeBee.

Officer McCullough developed Probable Cause to arrest BeBee for felony Harassment Threats to Kill. I also have Probable Cause to charge BeBee for Obstructing, Resisting, and Minor in Possession of Alcohol. See other officer's reports.

On 08/31/10 at approx. 1930 hrs. I was dispatched, along with other SPD officers, to a call in the [redacted] block of W. Dean Ave. reference a male pointing a gun at people.

I arrived moments later and people standing on the street nearby said a male wearing a white t-shirt was pointing a handgun at people and fled east into the neighborhood.

Within moments I saw a male matching the description running south across the street, with officers nearby yelling "stop police".

Ofc. Stone and I were searching a backyard at [redacted] W Dean Ave. where we lost sight of him and Ofc. Stone saw him laying on the ground, hiding next to some bushes. Sgt. King arrived and clearly ordered the male to show his hands. When he did not comply Sgt. King deployed his Taser. Ofc. Stone and I moved into to take the male into custody. I recognized the male from previous contacts as Aaron Bebee. I asked him where the gun was and he said he threw it but wasn't sure where.

As we were walking Bebee out to the street, I saw a black colored pistol laying in the driveway of [redacted] W. Dean Ave. I asked Bebee if that was the gun he had earlier and he said, "Yes". At this point I remained with the gun until it was photographed and collected for evidence.
